Morcote, “the most beautiful Swiss Village 2016”, is a lakeside village that lies gently on the shores of Lake Ceresio whose historic core, characterized by a maze of alleys that lead up to the majestic church of Santa Maria al Sasso, is completed by the eclectic Parco Scherrer, dotted with pavilions and temples.

After the success of its first edition, Morcote celebrates contemporary art once again, bringing together the works of fifteen Ticinese, Swiss and international artists and the surrounding urban space. "Lo spazio ritrovato", this is the title of this second edition, aims to reveal to visitors how contemporary art can intervene in public places by changing their perception and inviting the public, through this experience, to reflection, or better, to the appreciation of the surrounding space. Most of the works will be specifically conceived for the exhibition that will unfold across the village.
